

Pack 50 Leadership Rolls Outline

Cubmaster/Assistant Cubmaster

- MC for Pack Meeting
- Check-in with the Den Leaders to see what help they need.
- Make sure awards are turned in for the months Pack meeting.
- Re-Chartering in October.
- Contact person for the Pack.

Pack Committee Chair

- Over sees the Pack Committee
- Holding a monthly Committee meeting
- Make sure planned events and fundraisers are happening.
- Re-Chartering in October.

Pack Committee

- Plan a 12 month Program
- Have a Pack calendar set by August
- Develop a budget for the Pack (dues amount, fundraisers & what the Pack pays for)
- Keep track of sub-committees progress for events or fundraisers. (Blue & Gold, Pinewood Derby, Popcorn Fundraiser, Can & Bottle Drive, 4th of July Parade, Camping Trip, Cub Scout Olympics and so on)
- Make sure Tour Permits are turned-in.

Den Leaders/Assistant Den Leader

- Plans and holds 2 Den meetings a month during October – May.
- Keeps track of boy's awards and advancement.
- Turns in awards list to advancement chair each month so boys get awards at Pack meeting.
- Plan 3 day trips during the year. (Community service project, Fire Station visit, Zoo, OMSI, Day Hike, Swimming, and so on)
- Make sure boys turn in Fundraisers.
- Keep parents informed on what the Den & Pack is doing. Calendar changes or additions.
- Have Fun

Advancement Chair (Pack Committee Member)

- Collect list of awards from Den Leaders for each months Pack meeting.
- Purchase Awards at Salem Scout Shop
- Get awards to Den Leaders the Friday before a Pack meeting.

Treasure (Pack Committee Member)

- Maintains Pack's checking account.
- Pays all Pack bills.
- Makes Deposits for all income.
- Tracks Expenses.

Pack Trainer (Pack Committee Member)

- Make sure all Leaders are trained.
- Inform Leaders of Training dates.
- Tracks all training for Leaders in the Pack.
- Tracks needed training for Leaders (CPR, Safe Swim, BALOO, First Aid and so on)
- Tracks Leaders Progress towards Leader Training Awards
