

Webelos Woods Q & A

I have had a few questions regarding Webelos Woods. Below are answers to some of those questions.

1. Can we show up on Saturday?

Yes, you can the event starts at 8am on Saturday. You will still need to pay the \$12 fee per person coming.

2. Does a parent need to come with each Cub Scout?

Each Pack needs to have two deep Leadership and follow the safe guide for scouting. I recommend that you have as many Parents as possible to help out.

3. What type of camping gear do we need to bring?

You will need a tent (3 man tent size maybe 4 man will fit) that can fit on an 8'x 8' platform (Limited space if any for large family tents), sleeping bag, clothes, toiletry kit, snacks may be a good idea, bottled water the camp is on a well and some boys don't like well water, Scout uniform and clothing for the predicted weather. Some fire wood would be nice to bring for your personal camp site.

4. Will our pack be its own Patrol/Den?

That all depends on the number of boys you bring. We are trying to keep Patrols to 6 to 10 boys in size. So you may be placed with another Pack depending on your size.

5. Will there be showers?

Yes, there will be showers available.

6. Does the Troop need to supply its own gear to host a station?

Yes, you will need to bring the equipment to put on your station. If you are doing the cooking station we will provide the food, but you will need to bring all the cooking gear.

7. Can we cook our own food?

No, if you come to the event you need to plan on eating with everyone else. It will be too hard to tell who has paid or not. **Exceptions are those units staying through Sunday you will need to provide your own food for Saturday dinner and Sunday Breakfast.**

9. Can we leave at 4pm when the program is done?

Yes, but please let us know you are leaving so we can give the boys their patches.
